Y DEDICATES COMPUTER LAB FROM DONATION
MADE BY LOCAL COMPANY CONNOLLY

The Wilton Family Y now has a dedicated computer room for children in its afterschool Neighborhood Club program as a result of the donation of refurbished laptop computers from the Wilton office of Connolly, Inc., a recovery audit firm. A ribbon cutting was held on May 25 and was attended by Connolly CEO Larry Connolly, COO Libby Alexander, and Executive Vice President Robert Alexander, along with Y staff and Board members. A computer room at the Y for our afterschool children has been a major goal of the Y for many years, but budget constraints have precluded us from purchasing the necessary equipment. We had an empty staff office available, but no funds for hardware. Connolly, Inc. came to our rescue by offering to donate laptops that were only a couple of years old so our students can complete homework and other school projects while they are here for Neighborhood Club. Prior to Connolly's donation, the students were sharing the staff's desktop computers, with limited time and space. The Y is extremely grateful for Connolly's generous donation, as our students will now have a room of their own to work on class assignments while being supervised by staff counselors. We thank Connolly for selecting the Wilton Family Y as a recipient of their generosity."
